



Memorandum of Agreement

Between



Campbellsville University, Campbellsville, Kentucky, USA

and

Citygate Institute, Dar El Salam, Tanzania

Date: August 1, 2016

Citygate Institute, Tanzania (CITI) and Campbellsville University hereby agree to work toward establishing joint programs, aiming to enhance cooperation between the two universities and to develop an extensive academic and cultural exchange, scientific research and other related activities, as follows:

The areas of cooperation shall include any undergraduate or graduate degree programs offered at either university which can aid and foster the development and growth of the two universities, provided that any specific program shall be subject to mutual consent in the form of a written agreement and the availability of funds and facilities at each university.


CITI and Campbellsville University shall accommodate in the following areas:


- a. Student group visits to each other's institution.
- b. Student exchanges where students can spend 2 or 4 years studying at Campbellsville or Tanzania.
- c. Development of joint degree programs where students follow a 2+2 plan (UG) and 1+1 plan (PG)
- d. Staff exchanges and visits; joint faculty/staff appointments.
- e. Joint activities (conferences, Webinars, Online Lectures, executive education programs).
- f. Short Term Student Internships/Certificate Based Courses
- g. Exchange of information and any other cooperative project identified by the Partners.

2. The terms and details of this mutual understanding and agreement shall be negotiated and, prior to the initiation of any particular program or related activities, a written definitive agreement must be signed by the two universities to recognize formally the terms and limitations in which those programs and activities can be pursued.

3. This MOA shall take effect from the date of the last signature hereto affixed and shall be valid for an initial period of three years in the first instance. This MOU may be amended by the mutual consent of the parties provided that all amendments shall be recorded in writing and signed by both parties.

4. This MOA may be terminated at any time by the mutual written agreement of both parties. It may also be terminated by either party upon giving one months notice in writing of its desire to do so to the other party. In the event of any termination of this MOU, any on-going projects that are subject to separate written agreements, as contemplated by paragraph 2 above, will continue in accordance with the terms of the separate agreement(s).
