ADDENDUM TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between

Elizabethtown Community and Technical College Associate in Applied Science Degree Program in Early Childhood Education and

Campbellsville University Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education and Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education

PURPOSE:

To expand upon the existing Memorandum of Agreement between Elizabethtown Community and Technical College (ECTC) and Campbellsville University (Campbellsville) to include the reverse transfer of credit, and to include Campbellsville's use of ECTC's Early Childhood Education facilities and learning resources.

CONDITIONS OF AGREEMENT:

Reverse Transfer of Credit

- 1. ECTC students who transfer to Campbellsville prior to earning their Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree in Early Childhood Education, but complete the credits to satisfy the requirements for the AAS while working toward their Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education and Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education at Campbellsville, will be eligible to have these credits evaluated by ECTC, and if these credits are determined to fulfill the requirements for the AAS degree, the credits will be transferred in reverse (from Campbellsville to ECTC), and ECTC will grant the AAS degree.
- 2. Campbellsville will notify the ECTC Registrar when a student is eligible to have credits earned at Campbellsville evaluated for reverse transfer credit.

ECTC Early Childhood Education Facility and Learning Resource Use

- 1. ECTC and Campbellsville will discuss the possibility of sharing Early Childhood Education classroom space and learning resources on a semester-to-semester basis. ECTC will determine whether Early Childhood Education classroom space and learning resources are available for use by Campbellsville.
- 2. If Early Childhood Education classroom space and resources are available, Campbellsville will use the available space and learning resources free-of charge.
- 3. Usage of the Early Childhood Education classroom space and learning resources by Campbellsville's faculty and students shall conform to ECTC's calendar and regulations for usage of classroom space and learning materials.
