Requirements for Graduate Assistantships

- Completed application to CU Graduate School and School of Music.
- Graduate Assistants must carry a minimum of six credit hours each semester, i.e., full time status.
- Graduate Assistants must maintain a GPA of 3.0, demonstrating good academic progress.
- Assistantships are given for one year at a time and are renewable for one additional year.
- Graduate Assistants are evaluated in writing by the teacher(s) supervising the Assistantship assignment(s) during every spring semester. These evaluations will be shared with the student; a copy of the evaluation will be placed in the student's School of Music file. If a student is not successful in the work assignment, the Graduate Assistantship Committee, in consultation with faculty, may decide to not renew the Assistantship for the subsequent academic year (or may change the student's assignment).
- Responsibilities require up to 15 hours per week, and the stipend ranges up to \$4,000 per academic year.
