



## **Campbellsville University Intramural Policies**

**Intramurals are an extension of the Student Activities Department. Intramural activities are directly supervised by the Intramural Assistant and Director of Student Activities.**

### **Registration:**

All intramural participants must be registered on IMleagues.com using a valid Campbellsville University ID and email address. All required information must be completed including waiver form. Participants will create teams or sign up as a free agent on IMleagues in order to participate in active leagues.

### **Participants:**

Intramural participants allowed to play are as follows: currently enrolled Campbellsville University students, staff, faculty and spouse of student, staff or faculty. One varsity player and two Junior Varsity players are allowed on each team with clearance given from Athletic coach.

### **Liability:**

Campbellsville University, staff, faculty and board of Trustees are not liable for any participant bodily injury, loss or damaged property that may occur during intramural activities. The Board of Trustees of Campbellsville University, its officers, agents or employees are indemnified and held harmless from any claim which may be made against them arising from intramural participation in said sport, including court costs and attorney's fee.

### **Team Names:**

Intramural team names must be approved by the Intramural Assistant prior to the start of the season. Approval of team on IMleagues.com will indicate team name approval. Unacceptable team names are names deemed inappropriate, harmful to others, or lacking to hold true to university values. Intramural shirts must also be appropriate according to university values and requirements.



### **Participant Behavior:**

Participants and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner true to the values of Campbellsville University. Failure to comply can result in ejection from game, suspension from league, and other university sanctions.

**-Foul Language:** Foul language will not be tolerated during intramural activities. In case of foul language a warning will be issued at the beginning of a game. This warning operates for the entire team. Upon second infraction penalty will be given to team.

**-Altercation:** In case of a physical altercation, game will be cancelled. Teams must vacate area for remainder of night. Participants involved in incident will be required to meet with the Director of Student Activities the following day.

**-Insubordination:** Insubordination towards university representative: In such case the student or students will be suspended from the intramural league with possible additional sanctions.

### **Schedules:**

Game schedules will be posted on Imleagues.com and are subject to change due to weather, conflict of events and other unforeseen occurrences.

### **General Game Practices:**

**Prayer:** Before each game teams will gather to pray under the guidance of intramural assistant or intramural official.

**Grace period:** Teams are given 10 minute grace period after designated start time. Continual infractions may result in forfeit.

**Forfeits:** Forfeits may occur due to lack of required participants, altercation, playing with unregistered participants, and team no show.

**Cancellations:** Game cancellations can occur due to weather, behavioral infractions, loss of teams and other reasons. Teams will be notified via Imleagues and Student life social media accounts.

### **Work-Study:**

Work study positions to serve as an intramural official are available each year. Officials are to be treated as Student Activities Staff. For more information concerning work study opportunities contact the financial aid office and the Director of Student Activities.
