<p>Summary: Campbellsville University is seeking a tenure-track assistant professor in mass communication with expertise in journalism and public relations. Position begins August 2019. Rank will be determined by academic credentials and experience.</p> <p>Qualifications: Earned doctorate in mass communications preferred. Will consider applicants with master's degree and experience in the field.</p> <p>Responsibilities: Successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate mass communications, journalism, and public relations classes. Candidate should also be able to teach introduction to communication courses, teach face-to-face and online classes, and be willing to supervise the campus newspaper. Normal course load is 27 hours per academic year. Undergraduate advising is also part of teaching responsibilities. Successful candidate may also assist with student publications, broadcasts, and/or student-produced social media.</p> <p>The Department: The Department of Mass Communications at Campbellsville University offers an area in mass communication; majors in broadcasting and digital media, film, journalism, and public relations. Minors are offered in broadcasting and digital media, film, journalism, photojournalism, and public relations. The department operates a campus radio and television station, produces programming for the web and numerous publications including a campus newspaper. Enrollment in the department is about 90 and has increased each year for the last several years. The department employs three full-time faculty and several adjuncts.</p> <p>Campbellsville University, a comprehensive Christian institution offering undergraduate (associate and baccalaureate) and graduate (master's level) programs, stresses academic excellence solidly grounded in the liberal arts, personal growth, integrity, and fellowship within a caring environment.
