



Concurrent Enrollment Plan
Associate Degree in Nursing and Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Rationale: Students entering the School of Nursing frequently bring with them many college credits from either dual credit high school courses or possibly transfer credits from other colleges or universities. Students often wish to seek the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree, and wish to work on credits toward that program while still enrolled in the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program. This policy outlines a means whereby students can complete coursework toward both degrees simultaneously with the ultimate goal of completing their BSN degree.

Policy: Students may enroll in the BSN degree plan while completing coursework for their ADN. The student must declare BSN as his/her major and must sign a declaration of intent to complete the BSN degree. This alerts the Office of Student Records and the Office of Student Financial Aid that the student may complete courses toward the BSN while achieving coursework for ADN. This will allow students to complete general education courses and support courses for the BSN program with the exception of restricted upper level BSN core nursing courses as listed below:

- NUR 350 Advanced Health Assessment
- NUR 360 Transcultural Nursing
- NUR 370 Community Health Nursing I
- NUR 371 Community Health Nursing II
- NUR 380 Gerontology Nursing I
- NUR 381 Gerontology Nursing II
- NUR 410 Professional Nursing Leadership Capstone

These courses must be reserved for after completion of ADN coursework and licensure through the Kentucky Board of Nursing, since the nature of the Campbellsville University RN to BSN Program is a post-licensure completion program.

Potential benefits of choosing to pursue the BSN while enrolled in the ADN program include: accelerated completion of the bachelor's degree with implications for job placement and improved opportunities for job selection after graduation. Students will have accessibility to financial aid and institutional scholarship monies as qualified throughout the four-year period for obtaining the BSN degree. Students who are concurrently enrolled will be honored at the annual pinning ceremony for nursing upon completion of ADN requirements. A white coat ceremony will be conducted to signify the importance of continuing study for the BSN degree.

Students will be expected to maintain continuous full-time enrollment until completion of the BSN degree. After completion of the requirements for the ADN degree, that degree will be posted to selected clearinghouses to indicate completion and the student's name will be released to the Kentucky Board of Nursing for licensure purposes. Students will not officially graduate until the BSN is completed. The ADN degree will be conferred with the BSN degree upon completion of that program, and completion dates for the degrees will be listed as the date of completion of the BSN degree.



Designation of Program Selection for Admission to the School of Nursing

- Option 1—Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) Program**
I have been counseled regarding the program options available to me as a student in Campbellsville University School of Nursing. I elect to enter the ADN track and will follow the curriculum as designated within that track.
- Option 2—Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AAS) Program**

- Option 3—Concurrent Enrollment Program for Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree**

_____ I have been counseled regarding the program options available to me as a student in Campbellsville University School of Nursing. I elect to enter the CEP track and will follow the curriculum as designated with that track. I declare my major as BSN.

_____ I recognize that I must maintain continuous full-time enrollment until completion of the BSN degree.

_____ I understand that in the four-year plan for the BSN, I will be charged tuition rates specific to campus attending and will be eligible for existing financial aid, scholarship and grant opportunities as they apply to my tuition.

_____ I understand that I will be allowed to take general education and support courses for the BSN in conjunction with ADN/AAS courses, but will not be allowed to take the designated restricted upper level BSN coursework until I have met the requirements for the ADN/AAS degree and have passed the NCLEX-RN.

_____ I understand that the ADN/AAS degree will be conferred at the same time as the BSN degree upon graduation.

_____ I understand that my name will be released to the Kentucky Board of Nursing upon completion of the ADN/AAS requirements and that I will be allowed to take the NCLEX-RN for licensure according to the policies of the KBN.

_____ I have reviewed the policies and procedures related to acceptance of financial aid and understand my obligations.
