Campbellsville University, like most other higher education institutions, is nearing the completion of its first academic year under the newest Title IX regulation released in May 2020, which took effect on August 14, 2020. Throughout the year, the our office has been working toward successful implementation of this new policy with careful attention to compliance and will now begin crafting a vision for our Title IX praxis to also reflect our distinct Christian identity.

To help us achieve this goal, we need your input! Beginning on Monday, April 5, 2021 we will be opening our **CU Gender Equity Climate Survey**. This survey will be an integral component in strengthening our efforts toward prevention, education, and overall response. The **CU Gender Equity Climate Survey** inquires about issues related to gender equity and individual experiences of you, our campus stakeholders.
