Start date is Spring Semester 2018 (January 8, 2018).</p> <p>The candidate for this position must possess a terminal degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D.) in some facet of pastoral ministry (with an emphasis in two or more areas: leadership, spiritual formation, proclamation, pastoral care & counseling, evangelism/missions, intergenerational ministry). The candidate is an active practitioner in church and ministry leadership, willing to partner and network with local churches, and able to articulate a convincing philosophy for Christian higher education and of ministry preparation within that context.</p> <p>The candidate must be of high moral character; passionate and fruitful in his or her Christian vocation, with at least 2-3 years of successful teaching experience in a college/university setting preferred; able to invest in both traditional and adult students from a variety of spiritual and denominational backgrounds; open to teaching all modalities (on campus, online, and regional centers).</p> <p>Campbellsville University, a comprehensive Christian institution offering undergraduate (associate and baccalaureate) and graduate (master's level) programs, stresses academic excellence solidly grounded in the liberal arts, personal growth, integrity, and fellowship within a caring environment.
